To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform the essential job functions satisfactorily. ## **JOB SUMMARY:**

Serves the general public in a professional manor. Performs general routine veterinary assistant skills, clerical skills, janitorial skills, and animal control assistance.

## ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS (not all inclusive):

- Care for animals housed at the Animal Shelter location.
- Feed, water, groom, and clean animals kept at the shelter.
- Filing and maintaining daily and monthly records/ reports.
- Answer phone and other receptionist duties.
- Operate office equipment such as computer, copier, fax, calculator, etc.
- Greet and assist public in a courteous and professional manner upon arrival.
- Receive incoming calls, and complaints. Complete complaint forms.
- Record all information on animals kept at the shelter.
- Building maintenance cleaning, sweeping, mopping, dusting, etc.
- When needed, assist in euthanizing animals.
- Other duties may be assigned.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

# **Education and Experience:**

- High school diploma or general education degree (GED)
- One to three months of related experience and/or training
- Or equivalent combination of education and experience

## Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Ability to read and interrupt documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals.
- Ability to write routine reports and correspondence.
- Ability to speak effectively before groups of customers or employees of an organization.
- Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals.
- Ability to compute rate, ratio, and percent and to draw and interpret bar graphs.
- Ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of concrete variables in situations where only limited standardization exists.
- Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.
