

<u>TIPS-OFF PREMISE</u> - is designed for businesses who routinely sell alcoholic beverages to be consumed elsewhere. The course will teach individuals how to recognize when a customer is intoxicated or underage. In addition to preventing the illegal sale of alcohol, store employees learn how to handle intoxicated customers and keep them from harming themselves and others. The intervention techniques reflect the short period of time a clerk has to interact with a customer. Employees learn strategies that ensure responsible alcohol service, promote professionalism, and enhance customer service skills.

Upon successful completion of course, a 4-year TIPS Certification Card will be issued.
