MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF OAKLAND MARYLAND

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF OAKLAND AMENDING CHAPTER 300, ARTICLE VII, SECTION 491, OF THE OAKLAND ZONING ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council of Oakland is authorized by Article 23A of the Maryland Annotated Code and by the Oakland Town Charter to enact ordinances to protect the health, safety and welfare of residents of and visitors to the town of Oakland;

WHEREAS, On January 7, 2008, the Mayor and Town Council of Oakland adopted the Code of the Town of Oakland which contained Chapter 300 the Oakland Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council of Oakland wish to modify Chapter 300, Zoning, Article VII, Section 49 General Sign Regulations, Subsection I (1) & (2) regarding LED, LCD message signs.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, that the provisions of the Oakland Code be amended to include the following additions, deletions, and changes:

CHAPTER 300 Oakland Zoning Ordinance

ARTICLE VII. Signs

§ 300-49 General sign regulations.

- I. Special provisions for light emitting diode (LED), liquid crystal display (LCD) and scrolling message signs shall be as follows, and also in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 300, Attachment 1, Table of Use Regulations, amended Subsection (63), and adding Subsection (64)[1] as noted below: [Added 3-3-2008 by Ord. No. O2008-01]
 - (1) LED, LCD and scrolling message signs shall be permitted for accessory on-premises uses pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 300, Attachment 1. On-premises LED, LCD and scrolling message signs shall be subject to the following additional standards and limitations:
 - (a) The illuminated portion of any LED, LCD and scrolling message sign shall not exceed 25% of the total area at any given time.
 - **(b)** No flashing illuminations of the sign shall be permitted; single-line message signs shall not change messages more frequently than one-second intervals and multiple-line message signs shall not change messages more frequently than four-second intervals.

(2) LED, LCD and scrolling message signs may be permitted for off-premise uses by special exception only in the TC and C zoning districts and shall not be permitted in any other zoning district. Off-premises LED, LCD and scrolling message signs shall be subject to the provisions of § 300-49 I (1) (a) through (b) above and messages on such off-premises signs shall not change more frequently than one-hour intervals.
